The Board of Directors of the Georgia Gang Investigators Association (GGIA) is excited to announce that it has approved the implementation of a Human Trafficking Gang Investigators Certification Course **on Monday, October 25, 2021 at the Prosecuting Attorney's Council Headquarters Building located at 1590 Adamson Pwky in Morrow, Georgia 30260.**

Personnel applying to obtain a GGIA Human Trafficking Gang Investigator Certification must meet the following criteria:

- Be a current member in good standing of the Georgia Gang Investigators Association
- Pay a tuition cost of \$100.00 (Add \$5.00 processing fee for credit card payment)
- Attend the entire 8-hour GGIA Human Trafficking Gang Investigator Certification Course
- Successfully pass the Human Trafficking Gang Investigator Certification test of 40 questions with minimum score of 70%

This certification class is open for all GGIA members who have successfully completed the Basic Gang Investigator's Certification Course. If you are in a full-time position as a Special Victims detective or HT Investigator and have a verification letter from your agency you may apply for this course.

Note: *Those GGIA members who have successfully completed the Intermediate Gang Investigators Certification Course will be given priority during the registration process.*

There will be required reading material provided to attendees 14 days prior to the class. These reading assignments will contain material that will be part of the final exam.
